Patients with the following conditions are good candidates for referral

Trauma Sequelae

- Tooth Avulsion without replacement
- Ankylosis
- External root resorption
- Internal root resorption
- Incomplete tooth repositioning
- Early intervention for condylar fractures

Potential Treatments

- Revascularization
- Decoronation
- Tooth Autotransplantation
- Orthodontic Substitution
